Youth Ambassadors for Service-Learning

The Network: CATALYST Ambassadors will work as a youth-driven team of California high-school students, who have already discovered the power of incorporating service into traditional learning.

The Training: Ambassadors will participate in the Prudential Youth Leadership Institute, an interactive workshop focused on communication skills, goal setting, team building, project planning, decision making, and leadership dynamics. Transportation and accommodation will be covered, but there will be a small fee of \$20 to cover food.

The Commitment: Ambassadors must be able to attend the orientation retreat from January 18-19, 2004; must participate in regular network-wide conference calls; and must be excited about service-learning!

The Applicants: We're looking for Freshmen, Sophomores, or Juniors, who have already participated in a service-learning project.

The Goals: Ambassadors will mobilize their communities around service-learning. One special focus will be generating support from Key or Interact clubs. At the close of the program, ambassadors will have the chance to showcase their work and will contribute to building an interactive web-space.
